Bolton Council in conjunction with Families First CIC is offering free training for anyone delivering (or thinking about delivering) activities for school age children outside of the school day.

ABOUT THE COURSE

This course has been designed to specifically address the unique safeguarding issues which arise in out of school settings for school age children. It assumes a basic knowledge of safeguarding and will signpost for those who need to refresh this.

- Safeguarding in the wraparound sector
- Partnership working and information sharing
- Making safeguarding inclusive in the wraparound sector
- Creating a safe environment
- The voice of the child

Course length

2-3 hours in one sitting but to be completed at the learner's own pace and we actively encourage our busy workforce to try ten minutes a day.

Format

The course is online and enables trainees to dip in and out at their own pace. A series of films, questions and practical resources are included in the course.
