- Explore practical advice and strategies to support parents and families;
- Consider how we can effectively target further assessments and interventions (such as WellComm, Language through Listening, Nursery Narrative and EYBIC); and
- Explore how to make effective use of the Early Years Pupil Premium and Pupil Premium Grant.
