What happens at this meeting?

The Start Well Quality and Outcomes Team will coordinate a personalised support programme organised according to the needs of the group e.g. support with planning, quality interaction ideas, SEND advice, SEF and action planning, or any combination of these.

At the end of this meeting, participants will have:

- A better awareness of the requirements around being an effective childminder; and
- A greater understanding of the requirements around the EYFS statutory guidance, EYFS development matters and the Ofsted Framework.

Newly Registered Childminder Network Meetings will be held termly (three per year) and will last for 2 hours.
