### Overview

Workshops and activities relate to current EYFS Practice, covering the Every Child Training programme.

Workshops will include, The Communication and Language Journey, Mark Making to Writing Journey, The Number Journey and Phase 1 Phonics. This session will focus on **Phase 1 Phonics**.

### What will I learn?

- Explore knowledge and understanding of typical learning and development of children;
- Consider how we can identify children below or at risk of delay and so improve early identification;
- How to ensure that the indoor and outdoor environments are used to progress learning and development;
- How to make accurate and effective observation and assessments to support planning; and
- How to use Bolton's Every Child Journey guidance material and resources to support quality home learning experiences.
