#### **Two words**

Wash/dry hands/body/tummy/back, wet hair, more bubbles, pop bubbles, happy face, sad face, brush teeth, wipe legs, tickle tummy, water gone





### **Short phrases**

Wash dolly's hair/head/nose/ears, dry hair with towel, lots of bubbles, more bubbles please, lets make a happy face, soap is very slippery, look in the mirror, squeeze toothpaste gently

Time for bed, get undressed quickly, let's read a story, look at the pictures, put on your dressing gown, eat your supper, drink your milk, turn the light off, go to sleep, climb into bed

### Single words

Table, chair, kitchen, food, drink, bib/apron, spoon, fork, eat, taste, like, don't like, mouth, swallow, open, close, meat, vegetables, potatoes, fruit, milk, yoghurt, more, chew, bite, water

#### Two words

Small table, big chair, drink water, baby's spoon, eating food/ meat/ potatoes etc., more milk, open mouth, swallow first, chew slowly, nice yoghurt, taste sweet, lick lips



### **Short phrases**

Sit on your chair, eat at the table, go in the kitchen, put on your bib/apron, use your spoon/fork, you don't like/like your tea, you want more drink, chew your meat, close your lips, take a big bite

#### Two words

Clean nappy, lie down, sit up, vest off, trousers on, dirty nappy, over head, wash bottom, dry bottom, smooth cream, wet nappy, wash hands





### **Short phrases**

Clean nappy on, take your vest off, dirty nappy in bin, baby wipes in bin, cream on bottom, dress over head, wipe mat clean, wash my hands
