## Ages and Stages Questionnaires, A parent-led assessment tool workshop

### Description

The Ages and Stages Questionnaires are parent-led assessments which enable parents to be involved and understand their children's learning, development and assessments. Each Ages and Stage Questionnaire identifies in specific areas where a child's development differs from age-related expectations.

The majority of settings and schools who have been using Ages and Stages Questionnaire: 3 and Ages and Stages Questionnaire: Social-Emotional with parents have said that they have reinforced the relationship that they have with parents and enabled parents to be more involved in their children's assessment and learning.

### What will I learn?

At the end of this training, participants will:

- Have explored the evidence-based child development screening tools:
  - The Ages and Stages Questionnaire: 3 (ASQ-3)
  - The Ages and Stages Questionnaire: Social-Emotional (ASQ-SE);
- Understand how ASQ-3 and ASQ-SE fit with the Early Years Foundation Stage assessments;
- Understand the value of using parent-led evidence-based child development screening tools; and
- Understand how the ASQ assessments reinforce the relationships that practitioners have with parents by enabling parents to be more involved in their children's assessments and learning.
