# Re: Additional children returning to childcare from 1st June

Thank you for your continued leadership, patience and engagement in building a Bolton wide approach to the crisis.

Public opinion on more children returning to schools and childcare remains polarised. As attendance will not be mandated none of us can plan accurately without gauging parental opinion to establish how many children are expected from the 1<sup>st</sup> June. We have requested a childcare sufficiency return and will share the findings of that.

More guidance is expected over the coming days and weeks. It is possible that elements of the guidance and the proposed date of the 1<sup>st</sup> June could change. We will keep the information detailed below under review and keep you updated as soon as possible.

We are also engaging with Unions to keep them updated with the approaches adopted in Bolton.

## **Principles**

We've continued to work with Nursery Owners and Managers to support a Bolton approach which will provide a common framework of principles and allow each provider to apply them to their own individual circumstances.

- We are anticipating that settings will begin to invite children back to Childcare from the 1<sup>st</sup> June.
  We are not expecting all children to be in childcare from the 1<sup>st</sup> June, but we envisage childcare providers to work towards this as soon as is practical and safe to do so.
- The health and safety of children and staff is the highest priority. Decisions to bring more children into settings will be based on a health and safety risk assessment. A template will be provided to assist you with this.
- Decisions will be made by Owners/Managers and/or Committees. Advice is available from LA officers in all aspects of recovery.

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### **Public Health Briefing**

Some questions have been received regarding the levels of COVID-19 in Bolton and the current Public Health position. Online briefing sessions have been recorded from the Public Health Team to outline the position and expected next stages. Further details of these will follow.

- If incorrectly used it can give a level of false reassurance. It is essential that all staff using PPE have received appropriate training in the donning and doffing of the kit using the link below, or they could increase rather than reduce their risk.
