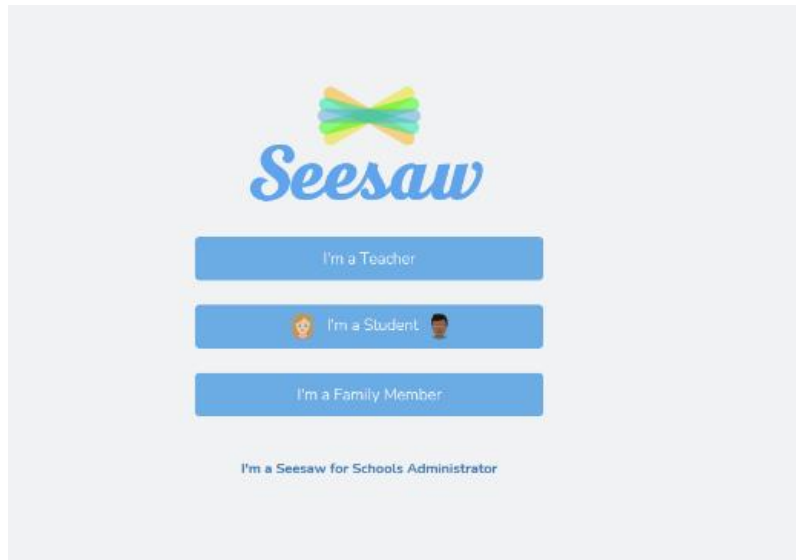


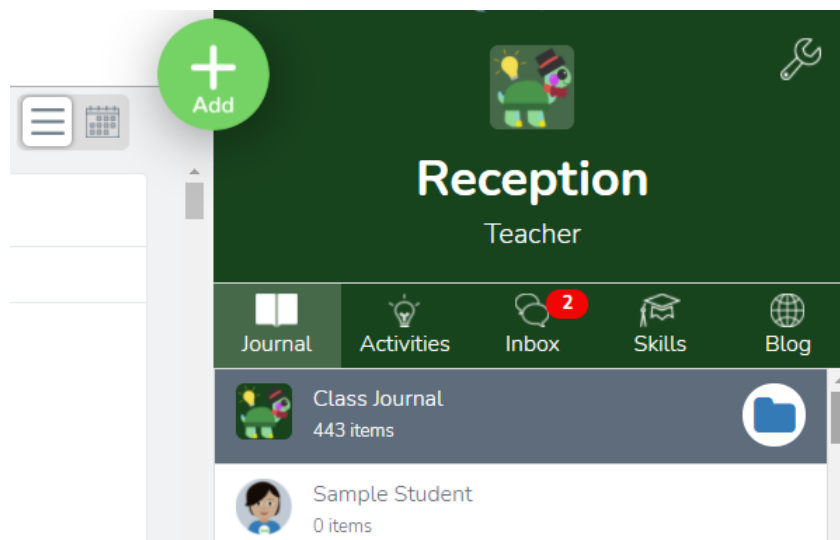
Home learning using Seesaw in EYFS/ Key Stage 1

We have been successfully using the Seesaw app to set homework and home learning for those children who have been isolating due to individual circumstances or bubble closure since September. We have been using it since January for all those children learning from home. Feedback from parents has been very positive; they have found it easy to support their child's learning and we are able to provide feedback to learning quickly and in a time efficient manner.



Parents log on with their child's login details to access the learning. They can also log on with a family code that is generated when the accounts are set up and this gives them the facility to message the teacher directly.

Staff set work every day using the "add" button. It can be scheduled so that you can create several days at a time and then schedule them to appear to the children each evening ready for the next day. They then return work as a photograph by just replying to the post which Teachers can review before it is added to the learner's individual folder. Families can only see the work their child has submitted when the settings are set to that level of security.



Work then appears to children looking like this. You can include web links, photos, documents and audio instructions. Children can return work using photos, videos, text, and audio. Teachers then provide written feedback for the child to encourage and support learning.



Seesaw can be accessed on a phone, tablet, ipad, laptop or desktop. Engagement is high both for homework and home learning.
