

## **Bolton NHS Foundation Trust: Paediatric Speech and Language Therapy Pre-School Complex Needs Referral Criteria**

## Criteria

- Child must be aged between 2-4 years
- Child must be known to a Paediatrician. There must be a clinic report from paediatrician available. Not all children who are known to paediatrician will be eligible.
- Child must have disabilities / diagnosed conditions which could affect communication skills e.g. Cerebral Palsy, Down's Syndrome, Autism Spectrum Disorder.
- OR Child must have significant social communication difficulties (likely to go to BSCIP). These children must have little or no verbal communication and their social communication impairment severely affect daily life. You must show evidence of difficulties in both areas in order for a referral to be accepted.
- Children referred in the last term of the academic year before they start school will not be accepted into the pre-school team and will be transferred to the most appropriate team.

## How to refer

- Paediatricians may refer into the service using a recent detailed clinic report as well as a covering letter
- Health visitors/settings/child minders may access the service using an Early Help Assessment Form or a referral letter making sure information on the following sections is included:
  - Attention and listening
  - Play skills
  - Expressive language
  - o Receptive language
  - Speech Sounds
  - Feeding/drinking difficulties
  - Sensory issues
  - Other services involved
  - Other medical/health needs
  - Advice/ Strategies/ Programmes currently being used

## What happens next

- If the referral is accepted, an "opt in" letter will be sent to families and parents/ families will need to contact the service within a two-week period. If we do not hear from the family, they will be discharged
- A Speech and Language Therapist or Assistant will then be in touch with the family to take a case history and arrange an appointment.
- NOTE: If a child does not meet the criteria above, the referral may be rejected or passed to the Early Year's Language and Communication Development Service for review.
